

## Quilt Entry Form Instructions

Submit one Entry Claim Form for each item entered. This entire form must be completed, signed in two places and **postmarked by April 5, 2010**. Entry forms should be mailed to Alice Cordell, 426 Meeting St., Beaufort, NC 28516.

### ENTRY DELIVERY/PICK UP

**ALL MAILED QUILTS** must be received by Nancy Smith, 248 Thurman Road, Beaufort, NC 28516, by Fri., May 7, 2010. Include with your entry:

- 1) a \$20 check made out to CCQG for the registration fee and return postage,
- 2) a return address label,
- 3) a stamped, self-addressed post card, or e-mail address, to confirm that your quilt entry has been received.

If you send more than one item, please add \$5 for each additional item. Mailed in entries will be shipped on Monday, May 18, 2009.

**Entry pick up** takes place following the take-down of the show on **Saturday, May 15, 2010 at 6:00 p.m.** The **CLAIM FORM** must be presented at time of pick up.

## Important

Crystal Coast Quilters' Guild will take every precaution to protect your entry from damage or theft, but cannot be held responsible for loss or damage of entry during the quilt show.

Be sure your homeowner's policy, or other insurance, covers the appraised value of the item while at the show. You must sign the liability release.

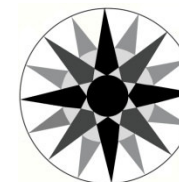

## QUILT SHOW ENTRY RULES

A quilt is defined as having three layers: a top, batting, and backing held together by stitching. Items made from preprinted cloth may not be entered. All entries larger than 40” wide must have a four inch (4”) sleeve attached to the top of the back of the quilt. All smaller quilts must have at least a two inch (2”) sleeve attached.

**ALL QUILTS LONGER THAN 90 INCHES NEED TO HAVE A SLEEVE ATTACHED 90 INCHES FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE QUILT. Quilts without sleeves can not be hung.**

All entries must have an identification label with the person’s name, address, and telephone number attached to the lower left corner of the back of the item and must have been completed within the past five years. Items previously entered in CCQG judged shows may not be re-entered. Non-CCQG members may submit up to three (3) entries to the show, with a fee of \$9 per entry for the first entry and \$3 each for up to 2 additional entries. The \$9 entry fee includes a complimentary show ticket. CCQG members may submit up to three (3) entries per category and pay no fee. CCQG reserves the right to change the category designation if an incorrect category has been selected by the entrant.

Items may be entered for exhibit only and should be indicated as such on the entry form.

## AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for First, Second, Third and Honorable Mention in each category.

“Best of Show” will be awarded at the judge’s discretion.

Additional awards will be made for best hand quilting, machine quilting, and Judge’s Choice.

Show attendees will vote to select a “Viewers’ Choice” award for their favorite quilt.

## CATEGORIES

- 1. Bed Quilt:** Quilt intended for use on any size bed.
- 2. Group Quilt:** Any bed quilt made by 2 or more people in a collaborative effort.
- 3. Wall Hanging:** Quilt intended for display on a wall.
- 4. Innovative/Art Quilt:** Shows personal creativity and originality.
- 5. Throw/Juvenile/Crib:** All Throw or Lap Quilts, Crib Quilts/Children’s Quilts.
- 6. Miniature:** (scaled down version of a large quilt). Longest side no more than 24 inches and block size less than 4 inches wide.
- 7. Home Décor:** Table runners, tree skirts, etc.
- 8. First Quilt – Any Size.**
- 9. Quilts Made by Kids** (14 years or younger).
- 10. Quilted Clothing/wearable accessories**
- 11. Challenge Piece** (Crystal Coast Quilters’ Guild Members only).

**Note:** All techniques are included in all categories; i.e. hand quilted, machine quilted, appliquéd, or pieced. Mixed techniques, special techniques, and whole cloth are included.
